You will be involved in all areas of the farm and you will be expected to help with:

- Milking and cleaning the parlour
- Feeding all the cattle and looking after any calves
- Maintenance of fencing and buildings
- Driving tractors and possibly other machines

There are 180 dairy cows and a very modern milking parlour on 180 acres of land. The family also own a horse, and Fran has been known to try hunting occasionally during the winter. You will find this family very welcoming and you will be made to feel at home. As this will be your home for several months, please treat it with respect and Fran will have no trouble teaching you everything you need to know about working on a dairy farm.
